Alley's house is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization providing a supportive, nurturing environment for teen moms and their children. Our vision is to break the generational, economic and social impact of teen pregnancy in the community. We accomplish this by providing comprehensive case management services, tutoring, life skill workshops, job preparation and computer training. Our services are free and available to pregnant and parenting teens ages 13-21.

Funding for our programs comes from individuals, private and family foundations, corporations, special events and community groups.

Our Programs:

Case Management Services

Assist teen moms in creating individualized monthly goals plans and developing a Case Plan specifically for each mom.

Mentors for Young Mothers Program

Match teen moms participating in our program with a volunteer mentor from within the community.

Teen Mom Groups

Groups where teen moms get together to discuss challenges, feelings, and experiences of being a teen mother.

Computer Training

On-line computer training is provided to all teen mothers participating in the program.

GED and High School Tutoring

One-to-one GED or high school tutoring in all subject areas.

On the Job Office Training

Teen moms can learn all the skills needed to get an entry level office position.

Life Skills Workshops

Series of workshops designed to teach everyday skills: nutrition, baby care, parenting (Love and Logic series), home safety, budgeting, cooking classes, job and career preparation, wellness and much more!

Counseling Services

Counseling is offered to moms who are active in the program. Services are provided on a weekly basis and are based on availability.

If you're a pregnant or parenting teen mom (ages 13-21), alley's house provides our 80/80 Graduation Program to help you achieve independence. Program tracks include education (tutoring for high school or GED preparation), wellness, life skills workshops, career preparation and finances. The goal is to complete 80 units in 80 weeks! Of course, you can complete the program much sooner depending on your motivation and willingness to complete the program.

All you need is motivation and we can help you figure out the rest -- step -by -step. Here's how to get started:

1. Call 214.824.8700 for a complete phone assessment.
2. Attend an Introduction to alley's house. There you will learn all about our programs and you can decide if you want to participate in the program.
3. You'll be assigned to a Case Manager who will work with you to create monthly Goal Plans to help move through the 80/80 Graduation Program.
4. Create a schedule at our Center to fit your needs.
