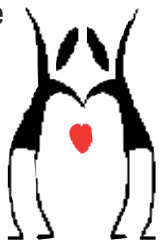

The Center is a coalition of agencies who meet certain standards in their mentoring programs. Potential volunteer mentors receive information about our program through this Center.

Volunteer Opportunities

alley's house offers a variety of opportunities to participate in the lives of teen mothers. Listed below are a few of those ways, but many more are available and are only limited by the creativity of our volunteers!

Transportation - Provide transportation to and from workshops. See the Program Opportunities brochure for the latest Workshop Schedule.

Mentors for Young Mothers Program - Be a mentor to a teen mother. Six hours minimum per month, 1 year commitment required. Work one-on-one with a teen mom to help her achieve her goals. See Mentors for Young Mothers brochure for additional information.

Tutoring - Put your expertise to work and help moms with homework or areas of difficulty. Meet with the moms before or after school, or the weekends. Math and science tutors are especially needed.

GED Preparation - Give teen mothers one-on-one preparation for GED examination.

Special Projects - Newsletter writing, donor mailings, website management, etc.

Special events - We have several special events planned throughout the year and many volunteers are needed for various activities. There are several special activities that you can host yourself, such as diaper drives, baby showers, donation dinner parties, etc.

Board / Administration / Committees - Various opportunities are available.

Workshop Facilitator - Facilitate life skills workshops—See Program Opportunities brochure for workshop topics.

General Office Training - Assist teens in attaining general office skills, such as use of MS Office, typing, answering phones, filing, etc.

Facts About Teen Mothers

- 40,000 U.S. teen girls drop out of school each year due to pregnancy.
- 50,000 new teen mothers in Texas every year.
- 83% of daughters of teen mothers will become a teen mother themselves.
